We then we have the lively Irish festivities of St Patrick's day to look forward to, The residents have been practicing their drumming in preparation for the party (photo to the right).






We are all looking forward to spring and have been enjoying time outdoors on trips and walking in the garden.... appreciating the seasons changing.




Join us for a history walk through St Helier with Blue Badge Guide,




